Wild Bunch Shoot

Beanpot and Hank are working up plans for a Wild Bunch Shoot following the June Match. Listed below are the guns and ammo that will be allowed. More rules will follow.

- * All ammo is to be lead loads, with cowboy action shooting speeds.
- * Pistols—45 auto (will need three 7 round clips), and broom handle Mausers
- * Shotgun—model 97 or 12 only
- * Rifle—whatever you are currently using for cowboy action shooting.
- * Long Range Rifle—Mausers, model 14's or 17's, or 94 action 30/30's

Beanpot and Hank are working out the details and when they know more I'll pass it on. This is just a heads-up on what guns will be allowed so you can work up your loads. If you have any questions give Beanpot or Hank a call.
