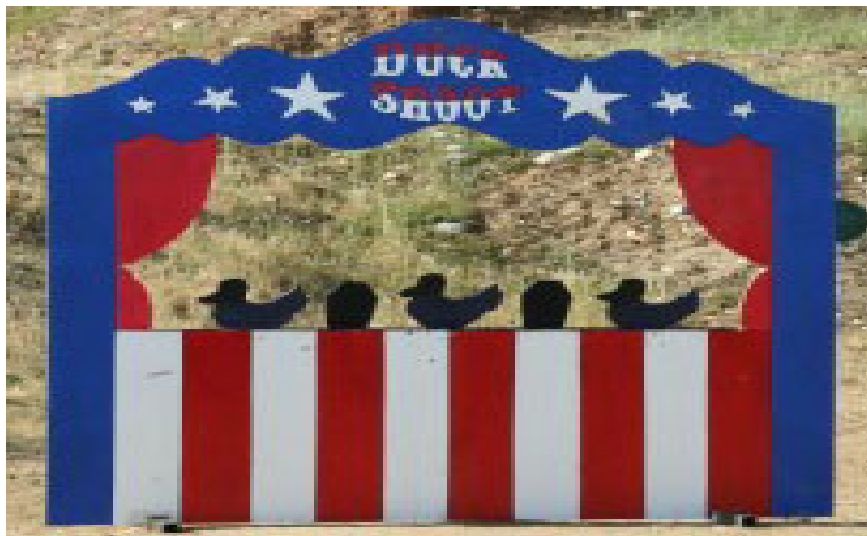

Just when are the rules of the game enforced?

When does sweeping or dropping an unloaded gun get penalized?

The answer is basically, "from the start of the loading table to the end of the unloading table."

That means, once you've put your first gun on the loading table until you pick the last gun up from the unloading table, the SASS firing line rules apply to you.

If you drop a bullet at the loading table, you're not supposed to pick it up, but have the loading officer pick it up.

If a gun falls off the table, and it wasn't the table's fault, it's a disqualification.

So, be extra careful from the time you come to the table, 'til you leave the table.

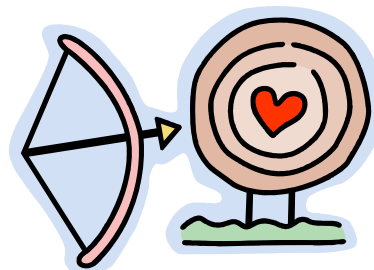


