

March Monthly Match Update

This coming weekend is our scheduled March Monthly Match. The weather, at least on Saturday, looks ideal, with no rain the forecast and Temperatures in the 70 deg. Range.

A weak weather system could arrive on Sunday, but the forecast quantities of rain are minimal. There is nothing in the forecast suggesting any problems at the FRPC entry bridge.

So at least for now, both days matches on Saturday March 18th and Sunday March 19th are both a "GO". If there are changes, we will send out an update email, post on our Facebook group page and post the changes to the NEW Event Update Button on the kingsriverregulators.com Home Page.

On Saturday, registration will open at 9:30, and the match will begin promptly at 10:00.

On Sunday, registration will open one hour earlier, at 8:30, with a required Shooter's Safety Meeting at 9:00, followed immediately by the match.

On both days, we will shoot five stages: One in Bay 3, two in Bay 4, and two in Bay 7.

The stages for both days will be fun and a bit different.

On Sunday you will have a chance to practice your skills shooting from the moving ore cart, then prove your worth at shooting flying clay birds (Annie Oakley style) with the rifle. On both days, you will get to practice on the Texas Star.
