


Rescheduled

December match shooters. Remember to dress warm!

The December match will be 8 stages.

We will shoot 4 of them on the CCPL range, and the other 4 on our range. The move from one range to the other will be as a group. If you start on stage 4, your next stage would be 1. Likewise, if you start on stage 8, your next stage would be 5.

The 4 stages shot on the CCPL range will be shotgun and handgun only, due to rules about rifles on their range.

Speaking of RULES, remember that the Fresno Rifle and Pistol Club does not allow a holstered handgun outside of the cowboy shooting area. Keep your handguns in your cart or blanket until you get into our area. I'm not sure about the why of this, but we must follow their rules.

The match officials will shoot the course at 8am Saturday. This will help to speed things along during the match on Sunday.
