## Basics

Bullets-lead, no copper wash, no gas checks. Handguns-Single action revolvers, min 32 cal cartridge, 36 cal percussion. Sights fixed or adj on cartridge, fixed on percussion. <1000fps Rifle-lever or slide action,tubular feed, exposed hammer, min 25 cal pistol cartridge.<1400fps Shotgun-side-by-side,w/o auto ejectors, lever action, pump with external hammer, no trench guns. Min 20ga, max 10ga, #4max, light loads. Shooters **MUST** be in period type dress!!!

Traditional-two handed, fixed sights on handgun  
Duellist-one handed, fixed sights on handgun.  
Frontier-black powder or sub, in cartridge or percussion, handgun, rifle, and shotgun.  
Modern-two handed adjustable sights.  
These are just a few rules, if in doubt, ask!  
**SAFTEY** is #1, Sprit of the game is #2.
