CAS UNDER ATTACK!

Our sport is being greatly threatened by two bills in the California legislature. Both involve a new technology called "micro engraving". AB 352 would require micro engraving on the bolt face or firing fin of all handguns that will transfer a serial number to spent cartridges when that handgun is fired. It makes all current handguns "unsafe handguns". This means you will not be able to sell any of your guns in California again. Also, manufacturers may finally say "no" to this latest attempt to keep handguns out of the hands of honest citizens.

Another bill, SB 357 will require every bullet in every round of handgun ammunition to be individually serial-numbered. The bill specifically adds .22 rimfire to the designation of "handgun ammunition". This law will also apply to bullets sold for reloading. After July 1, 2007 you will not be able to possess non-serialized ammunition outside the confines of your home. The first offense will be a misdemeanor, the second offense a felony. Each fifty rounds of ammo or each fifty individual bullets count as a separate offense. If you are ever convicted of a felony you will never again be able to legally own firearms anywhere in the United States. Many manufacturers are already indicating that they will not re-tool to produce serialized ammunition and bullets.

Please call or write your state legislators NOW and strongly urge them to oppose these useless freedom-stifling bills.
