- 1) Should we institute the following standard for all style/costume categories when breaking them down by age? The regulations for the base category will be applied first; THEN the age limits.
- IMO, this is a no-brainer... the category should determine the equipment and clothing requirements.
- 2) Should we change Senior Duelist to comply with that standard?
- Yep... I think we should. Right now Senior Duelist is completely out of step with the standard, when requires non adjustable sight in the Duelist ctegory.
- 3) Should we officially acknowledge th shooting category "Frontier Cartridge gunfighter" as a SASS sanctioned/recognized category?

This has been on the agenda FOREVER, and has never passed. Those who want to shoot it claim that there are plenty who want it, but they have not been able to garnish enough votes to get it in. I'm OK with it.. since the MD can set a minimum number of entries required to honor ANY category, it should not present a problem for any match. If the minimum is not met, it would roll back into either FC or GF category.

- 4) Should the MSV penalty for retrieving a dropped or ejected round be removed if done SAFELY?

 I think that it should be removed... we've tried to get it out for the last 15 yrs, but it always falls short of a 2/3 majority vote. There is a rule in place that covers this... if you break the 170 while retrieving a round... you get a DQ! How many times have you dropped a shotgun shell on the table and NOT been allowed to pick it up?? Seems dumb to me, but right now that's the rule.
- 5) Should conflicts on costume based shooting categories ("B"-Western Men's & Ladies and Classic Cowboy/Cowgirl) Costuming requirement determinations be relegated to the Costume Contest personnel/judges? Where the competitors can battle it out in front of a panel of judges instead of bringing costume issues to the attention of Range Masters and Match Directors to decide if a shirt or boots are in compliance with the rules.

I'm not touching this one.

6) Should the Category of Grand Dame have the name changed to "Golden Girls"?

A petition was circulated with quite a number of signatures stating that the name of the category was too stuffy.

Well, I'll go with what ever is decided, but it seems kinda dumb to me... just who is so touchy that they don't want to be called a Grand Dame???

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

*Discussion Items are not on the ballot for action. Discussion & Clarification only at this time.

- 1. Discuss the increasing incidents of "Shooting on the move", its implications, and safety concerns.
- 2. Discuss the possibility and any implications of the shooting category of B-Western/Ladies B-Western's costuming allowances to be expanded to include silver-screen style type costuming. Example: Senoritas, Tonto-style, Dale Evans, John Wayne, The Lone Ranger, Miss Kitty, Cisco Kid, etc.

If so, would the category name then need to be changed to be inclusive: "B-Western & Silver Screen"


